The Access Fee will provide scheduled appointments at Student Health or CAPS on campus at UCSD only, not other UC's and in house laboratory services. All other services may be obtained at UCSD Student Health, but there is an out of pocket expense for each service provided. For UC SHIP members, any service other than prescriptions are covered at 100% provided at UCSD Student Health. Prescriptions have a co-pay, but the majority of the drug cost is covered. If obtaining care outside of UCSD Student Health it is always a great idea to go online to our website at <a href="https://wellness.ucsd.edu/studenthealth/Pages/default.aspx">https://wellness.ucsd.edu/studenthealth/Pages/default.aspx</a> or call us at 858-534-2124 to get more detailed answers to your questions. For UC SHIP members, a referral is required for services outside of UCSD Student Health. You will need to establish with one of the UCSD Student Health Primary Care Physicians before seeking care at a specialist office or to have diagnostic services rendered. You do not need a referral for ER, Urgent Care, Dental, or Optometry. Students that waive the health fee are considered Fee for Service and have to pay for all services obtained at Student Health. Fee for Services patients may print receipts and work with their home insurance to see if they will provide any reimbursement.

**EARLY START UCSHIP:** (For new incoming students participating in Summer Bridge, Summer Engineering, and PATH)

Since your Summer Success Program begins prior to the start fall quarter, you are eligible for the Early Start UCSHIP (ES UCSHIP) which provides insurance coverage for the period before fall quarter starts. There is a quarterly fee for the UC SHIP <u>plus</u> a one-time supplement fee for ES UCSHIP. The cost for UC SHIP is \$743 per quarter. The cost of the ES UC SHIP will vary depending on your program start date. Refer to the Early Start UCSHIP Agreement form for cost information.

Students enrolling in the ES UCSHIP must remain enrolled in UCSHIP for fall quarter. <u>If you enroll in the ES UCSHIP coverage and later waiver UCSHIP during the FALL 2023 waiver period, your waiver will be denied for fall quarter.</u>

You must complete a MANDATORY Health Insurance Agreement form, if you choose to enroll in Early Start UC SHIP.

If you plan to waive the insurance offered by the school, you MUST file a health fee waiver online through the Triton Link prior to the start of your program.
